IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ!

*** for Fall 2019

EVERYONE age 18+ who volunteers with children or is employed by the Archdiocese must attend a mandatory *Protecting God's Children* class, and then be re-certified every 5 years.

If you have already taken *Protecting God's Children* and are reaching your 5-year re-certification mark, you have 3 options:

1. *Keeping the Promise Alive* is a refresher class offered throughout the Archdiocese, including here at St. John's on
SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 14 @ 8:30am in Conlon Hall
*** You MUST pre-register through Karen Clark; no walk-ins allowed.
2. You can read short, monthly **email bulletins**, and complete a yearly re-certification module. You MUST register for this through Karen Clark.
3. You can retake *Protecting God's Children* (see below), but need your original login info to register. If you do not remember it, email Veronica Chavez or Karen Clark.
